"We each started out by sharing a story of a woman who inspired us to be generous," recalls Marge Herrig. "It was so amazing hearing each person's story that I knew right then that this was for me."

This was the genesis of the Community Foundation's Circle. Ten years later, Marge is still an active member and regularly attends events along with her daughter Kristie Arthofer and granddaughter Whitney Sanger. The Circle is now more than 100 women strong, with members representing a broad range of ages, professions, income levels and charitable interests.

"The more we gather, the more enthusiastic we get," says Kristie. "These women just genuinely care; they want to know about you and they want to empower you—and it makes you want to do the same."

# What We Do

We have two meetings per year to award grants, celebrate our impact and enjoy each other's company. We also host opportunities throughout the year to learn about community issues and introduce prospective members to our group.

#### Make An Impact

We annually invite nonprofits working in our region to submit grant applications. Members who serve on our grantmaking committee research community issues, accept and review grant applications, and make funding decisions. Grants are awarded to organizations whose programs and services promote selfsufficiency for women and their families.
